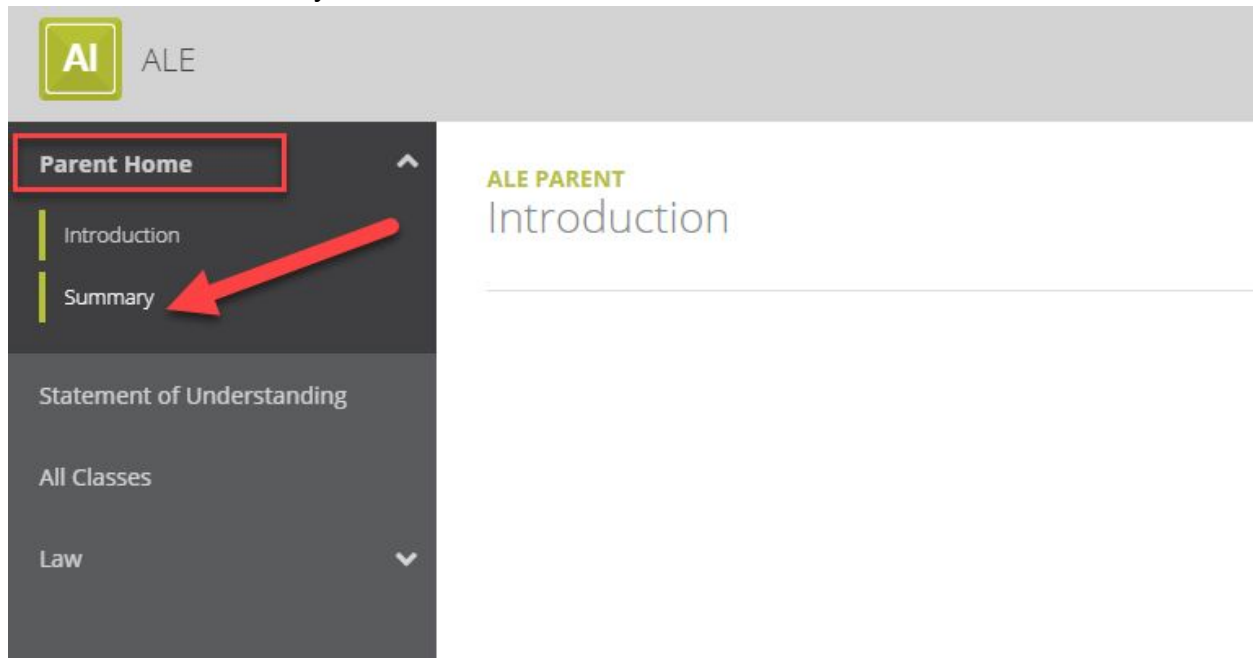
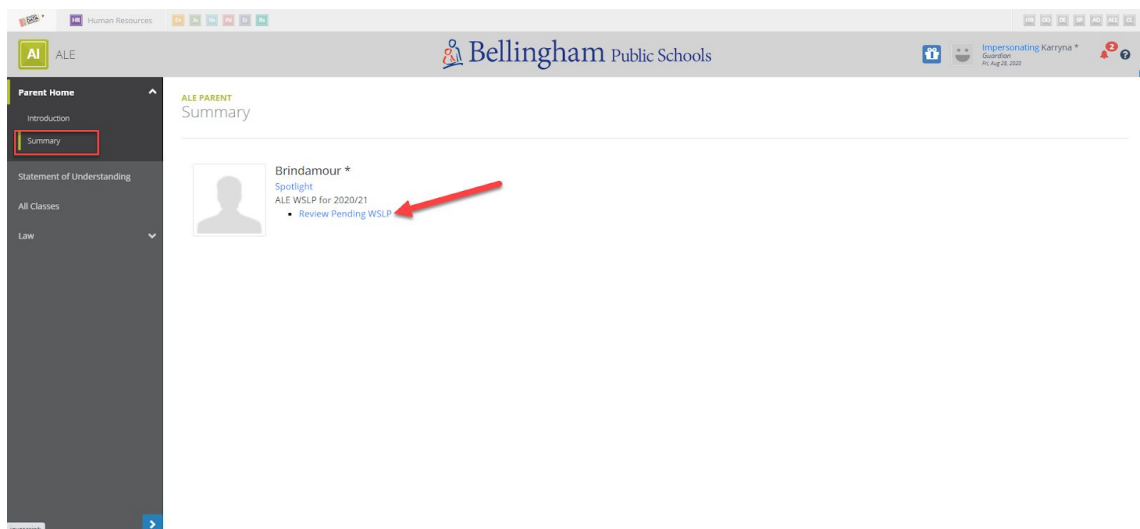


## ALE Application for Parents: Viewing the Student Learning Plan in Bellingham

Once you have logged in, by default you will land on the Parent Home page. Using the dropdown arrow in the left navigation menu, expand the arrow next to “Parent Home” and click on “Summary.”
